



Together is a coalition that **everyone is invited to join**, from community groups to some of the UK's best known organisations. Our aim is to **bring people together and bridge divides**, to help build a kinder, closer and more connected society.

In July, we partnered with the NHS to mark their birthday by bringing the nation together to say a great big "thank you" to everyone who helped during the first phase of the crisis. **Over 14 million people took part.**


This Christmas will be like no other.

How you can help





The Together initiative is teaming up with the NHS, Royal Voluntary Service, and other voluntary organizations, to ask your help doing two things:

Reach out to someone who'd like to hear from you on Christmas Day. Make sure no one feels alone.

It might be a neighbour who lives alone or is shielding, a family member you haven't been in touch with for a while or even someone you have fallen out with.

Call them up, invite them to join a Christmas game online or meet them for a walk in the park. It might just make their Christmas. Tell us your stories at #ChristmasTogether

Of course, it is important to do what we can to stop the spread of coronavirus even during the festive period. The NHS Volunteer Responder programme is recruiting new volunteers across England willing to offer support to someone who needs it this Christmas and during the coming months. You could pop round with their essential shopping - or festive treats – and have a door-step natter (you'll be matched to someone nearby), or you could have a friendly chat over the phone.




