With over 20 performances by young people from 26 companies, Gallery Space, and young people running the entire behind the scenes operations, Fringe 16 is a triumph in demonstrating the creativity of Fife's young people. Volunteers will be helping with street-flyering on the vibrant Royal Mile and also helping to complete Front of House roles.

Looking especially in the Levenmouth area, the opportunity to be apart of our Summer programme is a fantastic introduction for anyone interested in the arts - who knows, maybe next year it will be you who's centre stage at the Fringe!

The minimum age for volunteers is 16. All volunteers will be compensated with travel expenses paid and also have lunch paid for them. Volunteers take advantage of complimentary tickets to all our shows that don't sell out. Volunteers will be with us for a maximum of 20 hours per week, depending on your availability.
