What is the new Clinical Strategy?

 The Clinical Strategy will set out the future of health services in Fife for the next 5 years and beyond.

 The aim is to deliver more treatment in the community or as close to home as possible.







Why does Fife need a new Clinical Strategy?



- The population of Fife is living longer, healthier lives.
- The number of people aged 75 and over is expected to rise from 1 in 12 currently, to 1 in 7 by 2035.
- More people have multiple conditions, making their treatment more complex.





What will the Strategy mean for patients?

- People will be supported to remain well at home wherever possible.
- It will promote improved health and reduce health inequalities across the Kingdom.
- It will place a greater emphasis on the use of technology for the benefit of patients.







How will the Clinical Strategy be developed?



- NHS Fife is working with clinicians, partners, patients, carers and the wider public to review its existing services.
- The Strategy will be taken forward through seven groups, each made up of senior clinicians and representatives from across health, social care and the voluntary sector.
