- Co-operation
- Co-ordination
- Collaboration

JOINT WORKING

- > Threats and Opportunities
- Capacity / Economics of Sale
- Governance and Administration

RISK FACTORS

- > Risk
- Unincorporated Association
- Mission Creep (esp if charity)
- VAT: Cost Sharing Exemption
- Reputation

JOINT WORKING/PARTNERSHIP – LEGAL STRUCTURES

- > Two or more organisations
- Remain as separate organisations
- Creation of new organisation (SPV)
 - less common
- Organisations with expertise offering help / Sub Contractors

LEGAL STRUCTURES

- Group structure (MOU / Consortium Agreement)
 - Form new entity?
- Strategic Alliances
- Affiliated / Federal Structure
- Coalition

LEGAL STRUCTURES (cont)

- Risk / Renewal analysis vital
- Heads of Terms; Formal Agreement?
- Informal v Formal
 - Costs!

OTHER ISSUES

- Lead Partner responsibilities especially regarding funding
- Financial responsibilities
- People Issues

CONSORTIUM AGREMENT ISSUES TO BE COVERED

- Initial Members of the Consortium confirmation of details
- Eligibility criteria for Members
- Statement of shared values and purpose
- Agreed responsibilities of individual Members, e.g. Lead Partner, the recipient of funding etc
- Basis of decision making majority / qualified majority

CONSORTIUM AGREMENT ISSUES TO BE COVERED (cont)

- Nominated Directors
- Removal / resignation / termination of Membership
- Confidentiality
- Disputes / termination
- Boilerplate clauses insurance, notice

PROCESS / PRACTICALITIES

- Due Diligence
- Incorporation (decision making; need for bespoke Articles
- Conflict of Interest
- Contract with Funder may determine issues
