Referral Information

Aberlour Sycamore Services Throughcare/Aftercare Lifeworks Project is a new Service in partnership with Fife Council and funded by The Big Lottery which aims to improve life chances for vulnerable young people. The Service is able to offer support for young people who have been or are currently 'Looked After' and not entitled to statutory service (see referral criteria). Lifeworks will support young people preparing for and making the transitions towards a positive independent future. The young people will be supported by a team of experienced Throughcare/Aftercare Workers and trained volunteer mentors.

Referral Criteria

- Previously been looked after (at home) and who are not entitled to a statutory leaving care service from Fife Council Young Peoples' Team.
- 14 years +.
- Young people must live in Fife.
- Young people must engage on a voluntary basis.
