Fife's large and diverse voluntary sector consists of more than 3,000 organisations, run and supported by tens of thousands of volunteers. Our work impacts and benefits, in some way, every person in every community of Fife. We believe that is worth celebrating.

Our celebrations this year will be held at one of Fife's most iconic settings, the Old Course Hotel in St. Andrews. Those shortlisted for Awards will receive an invitation to the Ceremony, along with the person who nominated them.

The Saltire Summit Award is given to anyone under the age of 25 who, through volunteering, has displayed outstanding and exemplary dedication to a community organisation, school or a range of different projects. This award will be assessed by an independent panel of chosen Saltire

Ambassadors, community organisations and local high schools. Everyone nominated will be given a special recognition certificate; however a maximum of 12 Summit Awards can be given each year. The Summit Award winners (and their nominators) will be invited to the ceremony on 24th September.

SALTIRE SUMMIT NOMINATION FORM

The Saltire Summit Award is for an outstanding contribution to volunteering, and is for young people aged 12-25 who have normally achieved at least their 200 hour Saltire Ascent. They are normally nominated by the organisation they volunteer for or their school, college or university. Saltire Summit Award recipients are chosen by a Summit Panel made up of representatives from schools, colleges and voluntary organisations, as well as Saltire Ambassadors – young volunteers who promote and facilitate the Saltire Awards in Fife.

Please note this award is different to the Young Volunteer Award. Nominees MUST have achieved their 200 hour Saltire Award. Nominees must fulfil the following criteria:

- Have completed the Saltire Ascent (200 hours volunteering)
- Be aged 12 25
- Be resident and volunteering in Fife
- Be nominated by the organisation they volunteer for or their school, college or university. Nominations from friends and family members will not be accepted.

If you wish to nominate more than one volunteer please use a separate nomination form for each.
